## WHAT IS IT?

Lone Star Legal Aid (LSLA) is partnering with law schools throughout the state, in order to provide free remote legal services to clients who qualify for our aid. We are seeking volunteer attorneys who are willing to remotely mentor law students, specifically for advanced planning, guardianship, and pro se divorce cases.

## HOW DOES IT WORK?

Pro Bono volunteers select a LSLA case, and then we pair you with a law student, who has been provided training on that particular legal issue via LSLA.

## WHO IS PARTICIPATING?

Currently, LSLA is working with St. Mary's and Texas Tech law students; however, we have more students than pro bono-mentor volunteers.
